

ICE spends \$250 million a year on medical care for trans illegals

New Mexico is home to the only ICE detention facility in the United States that specifically caters to transgender women (i.e., biological men who identify as women). It opened in 2017, presumably under policies pushed by Barack Obama.

There are 400 illegal aliens being detained at the Cibola County Correctional Center in Milan, New Mexico. Of those, 27 are transgender,

Transgender detainees are given medical care and treatment, and ICE provides hormones to trans illegal aliens who are transitioning.

"I can tell you that it's not cheap," said Corey Price, an ICE field officer director in Texas. "We invest a significant amount into our medical. We spend \$250 million a year as an agency on the medical costs alone for those who are detained in our custody."

ICE plans to open more transgender centers around the US

The transgender ICE detention center in New Mexico has an entertainment room, where trans detainees watch television and relax. There's also an outdoor recreational space and a hair salon so the illegal aliens can look their best while lounging around the facility.

The facility also offers classes to help the illegal aliens look more feminine, "so that your femininity is more apparent to someone looking at you and questioning your gender."

ICE field officer Corey Price says the federal agency worked very hard to accommodate transgender illegals: "We had a constant challenge trying to find suitable accommodations for the transgender population, so we stood this up a couple of years ago, and it's been very successful."

ICE is planning to open more transgender-centric detention facilities in areas closer to larger cities.

If not, you might want to seek asylum**. It could be worth it for the amenities alone."

Transgender people make up less than 1% of US population

It's very trendy among leftists to screech about transgender rights even though they make up a minuscule portion of the U.S. population.

As a reference, there are 328 million people in the United States. Of that, about 1.4 million people (or 0.4%) identify as transgender,

has reported. That's <u>less than one-half of 1%</u> of the entire U.S. population.
